

ASIAN RELIGIONS MAJOR (effective F08)

Concentration in Chinese, Japanese, Korean, South Asian or Southeast Asian

Placement in Language Courses

All students who wish to take an Asian language course at UCLA must take the appropriate language placement examination (see ALC website for more information). The examination determines which course is most appropriate for the student's current level of proficiency. Students who have obtained college credit for a class may not repeat those courses for credit.

PREPARATION FOR THE MAJOR:

- The equivalent of intermediate level in ONE of the following languages through coursework or placement exam:**

Chinese (completion of Chinese 6, 6A, 10 or equivalent)

Japanese (completion of Japanese 6, 10 or equivalent)

Korean (completion on Korean 6, 6A, 10 or equivalent)

South Asian* (completion of Hindi-Urdu 6 or equivalent)

*At the present time, Hindi students will take their upper division courses in Sanskrit.

Southeast Asian (completion of Filipino 6, Indonesian 6, Thai 6, Vietnamese 6 or equivalent)

- ONE of the following civilization/religion courses:**

Asian 60, Asian 60W, Asian 61, South Asian 60 or Southeast Asian 30. *Chinese 60, Chinese 60W and Korean 60 by petition only*

South Asian- 110A, 110B, 110C or 115

Southeast Asian- Filipino 100A, 130A, 152; Indonesian 100A, 100B, 100C; Thai 100A, 100B, 100C; Vietnamese 100A, 100B, 100C
